County Commissioner Report: Commissioner MacLean was not present.

Reports of Special Meetings: There were no reports.

Zoning Administrator: There have been 23 permits issued.

Assessor's Report: They are working on residential property. There are new guidelines for agriculture property.

Planning Commission Report: There has been no meeting.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report was read. The balance of all funds is \$668,659.83.

Clerk's Report: I am preparing for an Election on November6, 2018. I expect we will have a big turnout.

Grounds and Park: Things are being readied for winter.

Assessor's Contract: Motion was made and seconded to hire Christine Ledergerber as the Township Assessor. The Township shall pay the Assessor \$31,500.00 a year. The agreement between the Assessor and the Township will be in effect until September, 2018. All were in favor, motion carried.
