The bridge on 12 Mile Rd. will be bi-passed. On May 24<sup>th</sup> the papers will be signed with the property owners.



Public Comments: A thank you was given for help on the newsletter.

The minutes of the April 14, 2016 meeting and the Special Meeting held on April 18, 2016 were presented. Motion was made by Rogers and seconded by Pins to accept the minutes as presented. All were in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Rogers, seconded by Pins to pay the bills. Checks #8755 through #8803 issued for total of \$ 28,774.63. All were in favor, motion carried.
