Call meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Greetings - Pledge of Allegiance

Treasurer Vacancy – Motion by Pins supported by Kronemeyer to appoint Ruth LaJoie to the position of Treasurer. Roll count vote Kronemeyer – yea, Pins – yea, Marsh – yea, Pulfrey – yea. Motion Passed. The Oath of Office was taken by LaJoie as administered by Pulfrey.
