Approval of Minutes of September 8, 2022 – Pins made a motion to approve the Truth in Taxation Meeting Minutes, support by Kronemeyer. Motion passed. Motion by Pins supported by LaJoie to approve the Minutes of September 8, 2022, as presented. Motion passed.

Pay Bills – Motion by Pins supported by LaJoie to approve the bills (check # 11546 – 11612 including 3 ACH payments for a total of \$63,584.22) as presented. Motion passed.

County Commission Report – none

Reports of Special Meeting – MTA Training was very extensive including addressing many problems, current and future.

Zoning Administrator – There was 1 permit issued and 1 Special Land Use pending (near 8 mile and M129) last month, Total so far for this year is 24 Residential and 6 Agriculture permits.

Assessor's Report:

A. None, due to training.

Planning Commission Report – The meeting was held on 22nd, working on solar land uses and broad band infrastructure, Special land use hearing and Short-Term Rentals .

Treasurer's Report General fund is 852,114.77, the Road Fund is 135,534.16 and the total of all funds is 987,648.93.

Clerk's Report –

A. Correspondence – Par Plan Grant Information

B. Hall Rental Contract – Pulfrey to amend the rental contract language of section 13 to read, “When cleaning is required, please be finished removing your property by end of your rental period unless instructed otherwise by the Township Clerk.”

Firemen's Report – 2 Incidents – Smell of smoke and Car on fire.

The side-by-side brush rig is at the Township and Training has been provided. The Sault Tribe of Chippewa Indians graciously provided partial funding for the purchase of the new Brush Rig. Tank and pump are still needed to make it operational as a brush rig.

Ground and Park Report – Grounds are in very good condition. And the dock has been taken out of the water at Dunbar.

Cemetery – the Cemetery is looking good. The artificial flower and such will be removed soon.

Old Business –

- A. Platted Lot Splits – Chipman and Pulfrey provided information regarding splits and suggested that the information be forwarded to the Planning Commission for review and recommendations. Recommendation was accepted by the board.
- B. Ambulance Service – No News. A millage will have to be presented to the public for funding of the Ambulance Service.
- C. 14 Mile – we have not heard anything relating to the engineering of any work done to the road.
- D. Scenic Drive Speed Limit Update – The MSP/County has completed the review of the section of Scenic Drive, north of 15 Mile and determined that the new speed limit will be 45 MPH. The section South of 15 will be reviewed within 90 days.

New Business

- A. Snow Plowing – The Township will be requesting Snow Plowing bids with a response date of November 7th, 2022.
- B. Up Collaborative – information was provided by Mirra Dose regarding survey needs
