Call meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Approval of Minutes of May 12, 2022–Motion by Kronemeyer supported by LaJoie to approve the Minutes of May 12, 2022, as presented. Motion passed

Pay Bills – Motion by Kronemeyer supported by Pins to approve the bills (check # 11320 -11373 including 4 ACH payments for a total of \$57,698.10) as presented. Motion passed.

County Commission Report – The newly appointed County Commissioner Mclean was not in attendance

Reports of Special Meeting -

Zoning Administrator – There were 6 permits issued last month, also assisting with the wording for the Solor draft.

Assessor's Report:

- A. Assessor Bids – Notice of request for bids has been put on the website and in the paper.
- B. Designated Assessor – a Motion to approve the resolution for Designated Assessor was made by Pins and supported by LaJoie. Motion passed

Planning Commission Report – meeting was held on May 24, 2022, with drafting of a Solor addition to our ordinances, also working on Master Plan and updates on Broad Band

Treasurer's Report: The general fund has 753,954.93, the Road Fund 2 has 483,374.06 for a total of 1,237,328.99 all funds included.

Clerk's Report –

- A. Correspondence – none
- B. Spring Cleanup – There were 101 residents who took advantage of spring cleanup
- C. FOIA – There is a FOIA request for election information.

Firemen's Report –

- A. There were 0 calls last month, there were random interviews, MIOSHA did not find any violation and only 1 recommendation.
- B. Tire Replacement Bid – is being reviewed
- C. EMT – the Fire Department now has a Certified EMT person and Chief Andrews is putting a EMT bag together, turn-out gear is being located.

Ground and Park Report – C. Person and S. Patrick did a great job of working up the flower beds. Everything has been mowed and grounds are looking good.

Cemetery – Next week the donated flag will be put up.

Old Business –

- A. Fire Department Review – There was an extensive review by MIOSHA of the Fire Department and no violations were found and only one suggestion was offered. To clarify some Board Member question, a work session is planned for June 23, 2022
- B. Storage Building Renovation – a section of the storage building is being looked at to make room for History documents.

New Business

- A. Auditor – Our current Auditor will be retiring after this year's audit. Pulfrey will be checking other firms to contract for next year's audit needs.
